Jamie's GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS™ title attempt for the largest cookery lesson (multiple venues)



Thank you for joining Jamie Oliver and Wonde for our **GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS** attempt.

Below are all the official details to make sure your classroom, or venue count towards the record. You'll need 2 extra people to oversee those who are cooking, and to submit 4 photos & 2 forms so that **Guinness World Records** can make sure they have all the evidence to count the number of people that took part.

THE ALL-IMPORTANT DETAILS:

1. **AT LEAST 15 PEOPLE TAKING PART** in the lesson and in the same room (plus 2 additional people to act as a witness and a steward)
2. **1x INDEPENDENT ADULT AS A WITNESS** (eg, a teacher, if in a school, or a colleague or friend) to confirm the lesson goes well and follows the rules. *Please note the witness **should NOT count** as part of the 15 participants and so should not be cooking the pasta.*

A Witness is someone who can act as the eyes and ears for Guinness World Records™, they will testify to everyone doing the cooking, staying in the venue and having a bowl of pasta at the end.

3. **1x STEWARD PER 50 PARTICIPANTS** (eg, a teacher, if in a school, or a colleague or friend) to observe and note who completes the lesson. We are all about the numbers! *Please note the steward **should NOT count** as part of the 15 participants and so should not be cooking the pasta. For every 50 participants within the same room,*

you'll need one steward (so if you have 60-100 people in your cooking class, you'll need two stewards).

A Steward is a person who must observe the lesson and make sure all participants complete the whole lesson & the witness has all the information correct. They are needed in addition to the witness, they can NOT be the same person.

4. **EVERYONE TO STAY IN THE COOKING SPACE FROM START TO FINISH** If anyone leaves early, the steward or witness must record this – and that participant won't count towards the final number. (This includes toilet breaks, so make sure you prompt everyone to go before the class starts!)
5. **EACH PERSON TO HAVE THEIR OWN PASTA DISH TO EAT BY THE END** Yum!

So remember, to count towards the record you'll need at least **17 people** in a room:

- **15 participants**
- **1 Witness**
- **1 Steward**

**If you haven't already then find a teacher, friend, or colleague and assign them these roles now! They won't be able to cook the pasta dish, but they'll play an essential role in making sure we beat the record!*

EVIDENCE NEEDED TO BREAK THE RECORD:

Then we just need you to send us some evidence after the event:

- 4 PHOTOS PER GROUP (no faces are required, so this can be taken by the independent adult witness at the back of the class).** There needs to be:
 - **One class photo within the first 30 seconds of the cookery lesson starting** – Our chefs will give a clear countdown so you know when to capture it. Your class must be fully ready by **11:00am** to ensure the photo is taken at the right time. Photos taken outside the 30-second window won't count towards the record, so please be prepared!

Tip - take a wide photo from the back of the room showing the participants involved

in the cookery lesson. No need for faces to be shown.

- **Two shots of the whole class** during the lesson (chopping, mixing, cooking, etc). This can be anytime between the first and last photo, and our online instructor will give you a reminder to take these.
- **One final photo of the finished pasta dishes with the whole class.** This must be at least thirty minutes after the first photo was taken. Our team will let you know when to take the last photo.

Please do not edit the photos in any way, they will not be counted as evidence if edited or a copy of the original.

We'll send you a secure link to upload all your evidence and photos. This will include the witness and steward statements to complete online.

**Please note that the photos we receive from you will only be used as evidence to confirm that we have broken the record.*

We will stop accepting evidence at 5pm on the 4th July 2025, so please make sure you get all evidence submitted as soon as possible. The quicker you do your bit, the quicker we will be to confirm if we're official record breakers!
